JF	Following consultation, AbCo agreed not to progress the proposed solution for improving parking provision at Crathie School. The proposal was not one that was favoured by the community due to concerns around enforcement and not adding additional capacity. The alternative proposal put forward from the community unfortunately would not meet design standards in the Design Manual for Roads and Bridges. Additionally there were concerns raised regarding the cost of the scheme compared to the scale of the problem at the school. It was agreed to review the situation in the future.

A useful Teams meeting was held on 4 th September. Further teams meeting were held on 11 th October and 12 th December. Next was to be in April but postponed until 21 st August 2024. Clearway decision at May Marr Area Committee now out for consultation.
